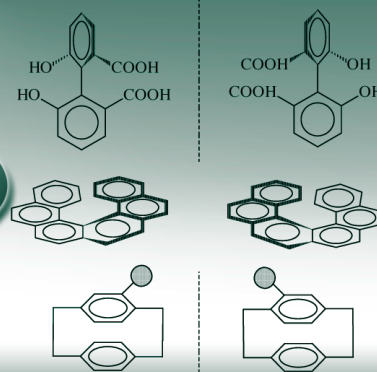

Topics also include commercial stationary phases and chiral modifiers of mobile phases.
